Key:

- Patient Dependency 1. a) Patient needs very high-tech care, with one-to-one nursing (e.g. ICU, HDU)
b) Patient needs very specialised care, where one nurse might be caring for a small number of patients and cannot safely leave the room other than for very short periods (e.g. immediately following major surgery)
c) Patient needs very urgent care (e.g. rapid admission following a heart attack)
- Accommodation 2. a) Single-sex wards (i.e. the whole ward is occupied by men or women but not both)
b) single rooms with adjacent single-sex toilet and washing facilities (preferably en-suite)
c) Single-sex accommodation within mixed wards (i.e. bays or rooms which accommodate either men or women, not both; with designated single-sex toilet and washing facilities preferably within or adjacent to the bay or room)
